| 3 | The Contractor shall place the required 2’ width of 6” deep gravel shoulder only to the extent room is available on the existing roadway. The Contractor is not required to provide fill material to insure a 2’ shoulder section on each edge of the roadway. |
| 4 | The bid item #1 “Grade” shall include all costs of equipment, materials, labor, fuel, etc. required to grade the area of the new asphalt parking and roadway pavement to meet the grades shown or required in the drawings. |
