Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Bid Form. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to Disqualification.

While we contend that SB220 should only be potentially applicable to a contract issued after the effective date of said bill, this is to clarify that for purposes of this contract, regardless of the execution or effective dates of this contract, the status of Utah Law and remedies available to the State of Utah and DFCM, as it relates to any matter referred to or affected by said SB220, shall be the Utah law in effect at the time of the issuance of this Addendum.

2.1 SCHEDULE CHANGES: See attached Revised Project Schedule - includes information on submission of Termination or Debarment Certification (highlighted).

2.2 GENERAL ITEMS: Termination or Debarment Certifications – Each firm must submit a certification on their company letterhead that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from soliciting work by any governmental department or agency. Each firm must also certify that neither the firm nor its principals have been terminated during the performance of a contract or withdrew from a contract to avoid termination. If the firm cannot certify these two statements, the firm shall submit a written explanation of the circumstances for review by DFCM. Firms are to submit these certifications with their Statement of Qualifications, but they are not considered in the page count of the Statement of Qualifications.
